COST

- \$39 per month (Primary member)
- \$19 per month (for spouse or dependents under 18)
- Memberships run from sign-up to May 27, 2022
- Memberships must be pre-paid in advance

RULES

- Members must provide their own towels.
- No FOOD or ALCOHOL or GLASS is allowed in the pool area.
- There is no lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk.
- Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Only registered pool members are permitted on our property. No guests please.
- No pool inflatable toys or balls.
- Members *must* present their card and sign in at the Front Desk each time they use the facilities.

TERMS

- We have a limited number of memberships available.
- Memberships are for an 8-month period starting in October.
- In the event of Covid-19 related restrictions or closing, the remainder of the current month will not be refunded, however the remaining unused months will be refunded.

NOTICE
